Motion by Murphy second by Bonsall to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Murphy second by Wingrove to approve March 12 minutes. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Murphy second by Wingrove to approve payment of bills. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Schauer second Bonsall to approve Building Permit; Bill Robertsfence, Greg Stinn-shed extension and Final plat on Weber Subdivision. All in favor, motion carried.

Jill Schaben from DCDC gave an update on projects and DCDC's year in review. Motion by Schauer second by Murphy to approve the pickle ball court and lights for the basketball court, this is grant funded. All in favor, motion carried.

Paula Evans gave the Library Report.

Mike Schwery spoke under Public Input about the restoration of the little girl on Hwy 30. Motion by Schauer second by Bonsall to approve relocation her to the North end of the Sports Complex on Hwy 30. All in favor, motion carried.

Joette Cogdill had asked the Council to put up a stop sign at 9th and Eagle. Motion by Murphy to not approve the stop sign. Motion died for lack of second.

Mayor Knickman let the Council know that the water heater needed replaced at the Sports Complex. He got two bids from Bonsall's \$850 and from Dunlap Plumbing \$1300. So, he choose to use Bonsall's. He also let them know that the broken-up concrete is going to Woodbine instead of Dunlap (Brasel's) from the sidewalk project, the city didn't have a say with this being a DOT project. He also talked about junk yards in town.

Chief Miller gave the Police Report.

Motion by Schauer second by Murphy to go with Ziegler on the generator for the pump house. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Wingrove second by Murphy to use Williams & Company for the City audit. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Bonsall second by Schauer to enter into a loan agreement with Community Bank (bobcat). All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Murphy second by Wingrove to adjourn at 8:18pm. All in favor, motion carried.
