Mayor Knickman called the regular council meeting to order on Wednesday, May 15, 2019 at 5:00pm in the Council Chambers, City Hall pursuant to law with the following council members present: Gunia, Bissen, Hanson, Lampe Absent: Klein. Motion by Bissen second by Gunia to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried. City Attorney Todd Argotsinger, St; Patrick's Attorney Kristina Stanger, Lisa Klein, Debbie Gaul, Joyce Cogdill and Father Joel were present for the discussion vacating the Alley between the Klein residence and the Parish Center. After some discussion a motion was made by Lampe second by Gunia to not vacate the alley. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Lampe second by Gunia to approve minutes of the April 10th regular council meeting. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Lampe second by Gunia to approve payment of bills. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Bissen second by Hanson to approve Liquor License for 4-County Fair and Smitty's; Building permits Greg Stinn, Community Bank, Jay Randall, Colby Greenwood, Robert Koesters (pending signature from neighbor), Lisa Klein, Jeff Lehan, Tony Casperson and Doug Melby. All in favor, motion carried.

Joyce Cogdill let the Council know that the sprinklers have been installed. Motion by Bissen second by Gunia to approve \$5700 for Fireworks this year splitting the cost with DCDC. All in favor, motion carried.

Meredith VanHouten let the Council know that her and Julie Elder got the City/DCDC shared website up and going.

Motion by Lampe second by Gunia to hire all the lifeguards that applied for the 2019 season. All in favor, motion carried. Kayla Bissen spoke to the Council about getting a new dock and removing the old one. The basketball court coving was discussed but no action was taken until after the cost of pool repairs is known.

Mayor Knickman let the Council know that he received a call from Mildred Cogdill about the Dunlap sign when you come into town, it needs painted. Motion by Gunia second by Bissen to get a bid from Tony Casperson about soda blasting and painting the sign. All in favor, motion carried. Mayor Knickman also talked to the Council about getting dirt for several places that need reseeded. Councilman Gunia stated that maybe we should look into having someone seed for us after we have to do work, this will be placed on the June agenda.

After some discussion about the After Prom can bin a motion was made by Lampe second by Bissen to remove the can bin. All in favor, motion carried. Motion by Gunia second by Bissen to give Luke Fouts a 50 cent raise for his certification he received. All in favor, motion carried.

Motion by Bissen second by Gunia to adjourn at 6:14PM. All in favor, motion carried.
