## ENJOY THE PARKS

Dunlap has three public parks that offer recreation and gathering spaces. Pleasant View Park has a dock and jetty for fishing, walking trails, a disc golf course and StoryWalk. The Dunlap City Park has a basketball court, expansive playground equipment, swimming pool, shelter houses and a Gaga ball pit. Schaben Park is located in the country southwest of town. It is nestled in a stunning woodland area with a six-acre lake, a campground, trails, shelter houses and a play area.
