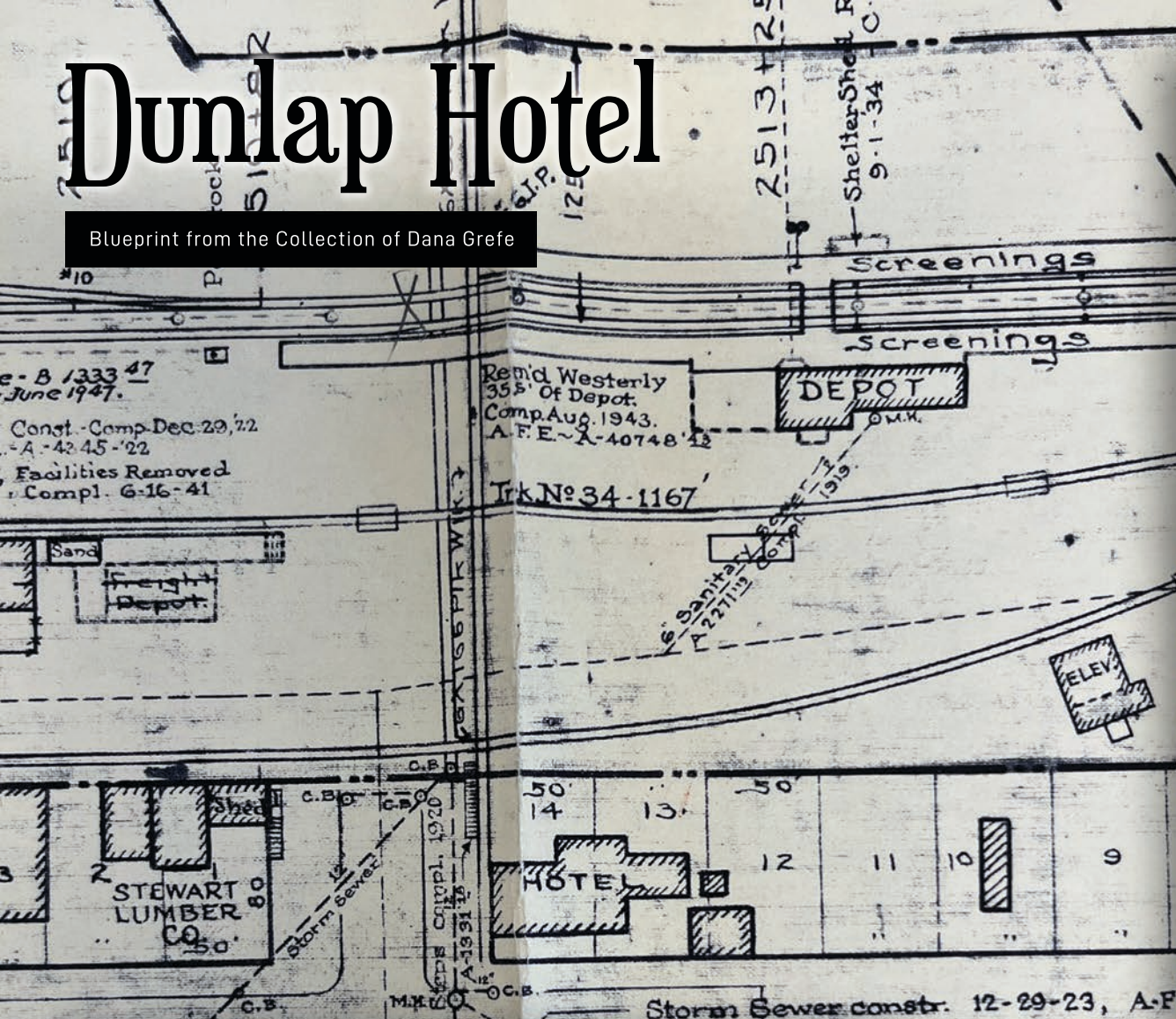


# Dunlap Hotel

L. B. Stewart, the new principal of the Dunlap public schools, wife and baby, arrived in the city last Monday morning, in time to afford the Prof. an opportunity to get acquainted before school opens. They are at present quartered at the Chapman hotel.

Dunlap Reporter, August 31, 1899

A workman for the C. & N. W. fainted away yesterday while working on a telegraph pole and fell to the ground. He was caught by some fellow workmen and saved from serious injury. He was taken to the Chapman hotel where he received attention.

Dunlap Reporter, November 9, 1899

A temporary walk of lumber was ordered built on the south side of the Chapman hotel, and new steps leading to the Northwestern right of way were also ordered.

Dunlap Reporter, August 5, 1904

Through the years, this landmark was variously called the old hotel building and the old Chapman hotel. A fire of undetermined origin broke out in March of 1967 and resulted in a total loss. The lower and upper flights of stairs both remain today.
